

## **Bayside Middle School Guidelines for Appropriate Dress for School**

It is expected that the students and staff of Bayside Middle School comply with Policy 703 (Positive Learning and Working Environment). To promote a positive school community, the following guidelines have been established:

- Hats and hoods are to be removed when entering the building.
- Clothing and accessories must not display inappropriate graphics, expressions, or logos. This includes items that promote the use of violence, alcohol, drugs/vaping or other illegal substances, profanity, or the degradation of an individual or group.
- Appropriate footwear must be worn for health and safety purposes. Bare feet, socks and/or slippers are not permitted. Clean, non-marking indoor sneakers are required for Physical Education Class.

All school staff can address students regarding the items above. Students who do not meet this expectation may be asked to change into clothing that promotes positive school climate, receive a verbal warning and/or caregivers may be contacted. Repeat offences could lead to additional consequences.
