



Dear Beaverbrook Families,

Welcome back to the 2020-2021 school year. I am sure that for many, the beginning of the school year has weighed on your mind. Please be reassured that the safety of students and staff is our priority. We will face new challenges this year and I am confident that, as a community, we will rise to the challenge.

Due to the ongoing global pandemic, please be aware of the following items:

Staggered Entry unless otherwise specified. The staggered entry for students in Kindergarten was decided in June and students will continue to follow that entry. your child will return to school on the following date:

Tuesday, September 8th: students with last name between **A-E**

Wednesday, September 9th: students with the last name between **F-M**

Thursday, September 10th: students with the last name between **N-Z**

Friday, September 11th: **All students**

Supervision

School will open at 7:55, there will be no supervision before this time. Students will enter at staggered times. Students from K-3 will enter through the back door in each classroom. The classroom teacher will be there to greet students. Teachers on duty will help guide students into the building.

Community Masks

Students are expected to arrive at school each day with a clean mask at their disposal. Masks will be required for all students when they leave their classroom bubble.

Screening

Prior to leaving home, parents or guardians are asked to screen their child for COVID 19 symptoms and keep their child home, calling 811, if symptoms are present. Students will be reminded to wash or sanitize their hands regularly, including each time they enter the school or classroom.

Becomes Sick at School

BBK is asking that parent/guardians be available for immediate pick-up should your child become symptomatic. As such, providing the school with several phone numbers you can immediately be reached at is deeply appreciated to minimize the risk and keep the school open.

Breakfast Club

Will be on a grab and go basis.

Closed Campus for Lunch

To ensure “bubbling” during the school day, students are not permitted off site for lunch, unless they are going home.

No Microwaves

Microwaves will not be used during the school day until further notice.

Nut free

Please note that Beaverbrook school will be a nut free building. Thank you for your support.

Breaks

Beaverbrook will be having two distinct recesses and two distinct lunch hours. This will help students keep a physical distance from students outside of their bubble

Water Bottles

Every student needs to bring a water bottle with their name on it. All of our water fountains have been replaced with bottle fillers which do not permit students to drink directly from them.

Beaverbrook school will be posting our full Operational Plan on September 3rd to our school website. This is a fluid plan, meaning it is subject to change as new information becomes available through EECD and/or Public Health.
