## What Parent/Guardian Needs to Know for Beaverbrook School COVID Response

We can understand that you may have concerns about sending your child to school during the pandemic. Please rest assured that every effort has been made regarding the safety of your child(ren). Below is a summary of information for you to review both before your child's arrival as well as throughout the school year. Please note this information is updated on a regular basis and should be checked regularly. **Arrival and Departure Information For students in K-3**, teachers will be using their side doors located within their classroom until December 01 unless otherwise informed. Parent/Guardian will use the side door for both the drop-off and pick-up of their child at the appointed time indicated below.

### Bathrooms

- Students in grades K-3 will only use washrooms downstairs
- Students in grades 4-8 will only use washrooms upstairs

### Breakfast Club

Breakfast Club will be available starting Tuesday, September 8. This year, students will report to their homeroom upon arrival with breakfast trays arriving to the homeroom starting at 7:55. All food is individually wrapped/single serving to lower the risk of COVID transmission.

### Cleaning and Disinfection Procedures

- Frequently touched surfaces, such as doorknobs, handrails, learning materials, etc., are being cleaned regularly throughout the day.
- Specialties such as Art, Music, and Phys.Ed will have equipment sanitized between uses and students will sanitize before entering the class and when leaving the class.
- There is one hand sanitizing station per classroom and one station per common area. Younger students are supervised when using the sanitizer.
- All persons entering the building are required to sanitize/wash their hands upon arrival.
- *Personal Hygiene Etiquette* will be taught and modeled by all staff throughout the year and appropriate signage (i.e. handwashing posters) is located throughout the building to further support this.

**Masks:** all students are required to wear a mask when outside of their homeroom/bubble

### Recess & Lunch (please send lunch and snacks to school with your child in the morning)

- Recess for students in K-3 will be from 10:00-10:15
- Recess for students in 4-8 will be from 10:45-11:00
- Lunch for students in K-3 will be 12:15-12:30
- Lunch for students in 4-8 will be 13:30-12:50

### Screening

Prior to leaving home, parent/guardian are asked to screen their child for COVID 19 symptoms and keep their child home, calling 811, if symptoms are present. Students will be reminded to wash or sanitize their hands regularly, including each time they enter the school or classroom.

### Signing Out

We understand there will be times when your child must leave school for an appointment. We would ask that parents inform the school of any appointments. Upon arrival, please call the school (856-3403), or buzz the main office. Your child will be escorted to the main entrance where parents/guardians (who will remain outside) will be required to sign their child out.

### Water Bottles

Students are required to have a water bottle with them as only the water refill station is available.
