Dear Bernice McNaughton High School Families,

Public Health is inviting your child to a Covid-19 vaccination clinic which will be held at their school on October 1<sup>st</sup>. For students under the age of 16, the signature of a parent / legal guardian is required on the consent form found in the links below.

The vaccine administered at this clinic will be Pfizer-BioNTech.

**If your child has already received both vaccines disregard this message.**

**If your child has only received their first vaccine against COVID-19 (must be 28 days between the first and second vaccine):**

- Print the consent form, complete it, and sign it. Give it to your child the morning of the clinic. Students must give the consent form to the nurse at their appointment. Students must bring their Record of Immunization against COVID-19 which they received at their first appointment.

**If your child has not received a vaccine against COVID-19:**

- Print the consent form, complete it, and sign it. Give it to your child the morning of the clinic. Students must give the consent form to the nurse at their appointment.

Students 16 and older can complete the consent form themselves and present it to the nurse the day of the clinic.
