Mask guidelines

- Staff and students and staff are expected to wear a mask in all common indoor areas of the school, which includes the hallways, stairwells, cafeteria while standing, guidance area, office, and bathrooms.
- Students must always wear a mask on school buses.
- In the classroom, students and staff may remove their mask. We will continue to clean their hands and regularly sanitize the desk.

Health Protocol
