

Academic Dishonesty Policy

Any student found guilty of being academically dishonest (plagiarizing an assignment, cheating on test/exam, taking credit for someone else's work) will face serious consequences for their actions. Students who contribute to another's plagiarism are equally guilty and will face the same consequences.

First offense

- Teacher contacts administration
- Administration makes parental contact and an "Academic Dishonesty" Incident Report is filed
- Student is to re-submit the work with a date set by the teacher
- No penalty on re-submitted work
- Failure to submit work by the date results in a zero

Second offense (within 1 calendar year of first offense)

- Teacher contacts administration
- Automatic zero on the assignment
- Parent meeting held with administration and an "Academic Dishonesty" Incident Report is filed

Third offense (within 1 calendar year of first offense)

- Same consequences as previous offense
- As well, further consequences may be imposed such as loss of credit
