**Update to MORNING DROP OFF AND PICK UP  
REVISED – January 4, 2021**

The playground is now closed during morning arrival and dismissal after school. There will be no outdoor supervision except at the drop off zone. Students will be supervised in their classrooms until classes begin at 8:20am. The drop off zone is supervised from 8:00-8:20am. The morning arrival is to occur from **8:00-8:20am** with the following requirements:

- Parents are to use the **Entrance** (second driveway off Whitepine Road) and **Exit** (third driveway to Whitepine Road); Stop at the stop line/pylon
- Students exit their vehicle and **go directly to their designated mudroom**
- All students must **wear a mask** to enter the building.
- All students must **sanitize their hands** at the mudroom entrance
- Students may **remove their mask** once inside their classroom

**Note** - Supervisors/teachers will no longer be opening the car doors. If your child is unable to open the car door, please provide them with assistance. Also, if you are parking please ensure your child uses the crosswalk to cross the drop off zone. **Masks are required to be worn until the child enters their classroom.**

**Mudroom** - Students will be able to **store** outdoor clothing and footwear in the mudroom at the teacher's discretion. If the teacher wishes to have students store items in the mudroom, students should immediately go to their labelled hook and hang up their belongings.

**Bookbags and lunch kits** - will be stored in the classroom.

**Winter Wear**

We will be opening our sliding hill to students on favorable sliding days at **lunch time**. Students must be dressed appropriately with a jacket, hat, mittens and snowpants. A helmet is strongly recommended. Kindergarten students will be going during their PE classes. The teachers will let you know when this will happen. All other classes will be able to slide during their lunch hour when they are in Zone 2.



The sliding hill is often used by classes throughout the day so we ask that parents only bring their children to use it at the end of the school day after 2:35pm.
