Safety Concerns

We ask that children do not arrive prior to 8am as supervision only begins at that time. Adults should not go past the pylons on the playground in the morning. We need to ensure student safety and thank you for your understanding and cooperation. When picking up your child afterschool please ensure you make eye contact with the teacher (k-2) so they are aware you have your child. Walking students are to leave school grounds after school. If at any time you need to pick up your child throughout the day ensure you sign him/her out at the office. If your child will be absent please ensure you input the absence into the new safe arrival program. Also, we ask that parents communicate directly with daycares if your child will not be at school or if alternate arrangements are to be made. **Please do not bring dogs onto school grounds.**

Fire Drills

We had two very successful fire drills last week. Announcements were made over the intercom to alert the students that we would be having a drill after recess. The students and staff were amazing and we are very proud of their efforts. This week we will have another fire drill and will practice our emergency evacuation

procedures where we go to our emergency location at the Whitepine Church. We are anticipating the drill taking place on Friday weather permitting.

As many of you are aware we have a very special canine member in our CDT community. Gaius is a service dog who assists a student in our school. He accompanies the student to classes and also on the playground. We would ask you to discuss Gaius with your children and please remind them when Gaius is working he should not be petted or addressed. (He is working when he is wearing his red vest).

Snapology After School Program

They provide a fun interactive environment for children to learn science, technology, engineering, art, math, robotics, movie making and video game design concept using LEGO® bricks, K'Nex and technology.
