Mudroom Usage

Students will now be able to **store outdoor clothing and footwear in the mudrooms**. The process of entering the school through the mudroom doors and going directly into the classroom will continue. Students are to remove their outdoor clothing in the classroom and then the teacher will take the class into the mudroom to hang up their items on labelled hooks. There is only to be one classroom in the mudroom at a time. The reverse process will occur for getting dressed to go outside. Bookbags and lunch boxes will need to be stored in the classroom. It is optional for teachers to participate in this plan of using the mudroom for storage. Teachers may choose to continue to store outdoor clothing and footwear in their classrooms.

Forms

Two forms will be coming home today that need to be returned as soon as possible, The yellow form provides information required incase the school had to be closed early for the day. (ex: power outage, snowstorm) The blue form provides information regarding allergies within our school. Also, there are forms to be completed for each student on **school cash on-line**. Currently we only have forms completed for 146 out of our 263 students. It is very important all forms are completed as soon as possible.

Kindergarten Registration

Registration for Kindergarten classes beginning in September, 2021 will **occur online** from October 13-16 for all children who will turn five by December 31, 2021. Oliver's Labels

In an effort to keep our students safe we will not be having a lost and found bin this year to prevent students from touching other student's belongings outside of their classroom bubble. In order for lost belongings to find their way back to their owner, all items will need to be labelled.

Our home and school has made arrangements for our parents to order preprinted labels that easily and permanently apply to plastics, clothing, water bottles and etc... The labels do not peel off during the wash! Please review the attached information sheet on this great opportunity.

Amidst the global pandemic our priority is always the safety and wellbeing of all our students here at CDT School. 1. *Fever/Feverish*
2. *Sore Throat*
3. *Headache*
4. *Runny Nose*
5. *Cough*
6. *Muscle pain*
7. *Diarrhea*
8. *Loss of Taste or Smell*
9. *Fatigue*
10. *Difficulty breathing*
11. *Purple marking on the fingers and/or toes*
