

SCHOOL SUPPLIES GRADES 9-12 (English Prime & French Immersion)

Technology:

This is the second year in a row that we are strongly recommending students be prepared for school with their own **tablet or computer**. Generally, it is difficult to produce quality schoolwork with a cellphone. While the school does have several older devices, these are not always available and have limited functionality due to age. The following guidelines for device requirements will allow for access the school Wi-Fi Network and Office 365. We suggest that devices be a maximum of 2-years-old apart from a Windows or Apple laptop. A device meeting the **minimum** requirements will not last as long as the most recently released device.

TABLET DEVICES

Android Tablet

Any device that will update to the current operating system of Android 10 (Android 9 will currently work), Wi-Fi and Bluetooth capable.

iPad

iPad 2018 6th Generation, (Current version is 7th Generation) that will update to the current operating system of IOS 13 and beyond. It must be Wi-Fi and Bluetooth capable. Both the 6th and 7th Generation iPad are compatible with the Apple Pencil 1st Generation.

LAPTOPS

Windows Laptop

Any Windows capable laptop that will update to the current operating system of Windows 10, Wi-Fi and Bluetooth capable.

Apple Laptop

An Apple Laptop that will update to the current operating system of MacOS 10.15 Catalina, Wi-Fi, and Bluetooth capable.

Chromebook Laptop

Any device that will continue to accept updates and be Wi-Fi and Bluetooth capable. Chromebook must be able to access and run the student's Microsoft Office 365 online applications.

Grades 9 & 10 Art, 110/120 Visual Arts: scissors, ruler, pencil, eraser, coloured pencils, glue stick, sharpie both fine and ultra-fine, sketchbook

Mathematics 9-12: Scientific Calculator (cell phones are not to be used in any math class at high school)

Physical Education 9, 10, 110 Wellness, 120 Leadership: proper gym attire, sneakers (no boots, no black soles)

Biology 112/122: lab fees \$15 for each course

Culinary Tech 110/120: \$40 for each course

Trades courses Grade 110 & 120: \$20 for each course (\$25 for each welding course)

Music 9, 10, 110, 120: Any student taking music should have their own headphones (long cords recommended). Bluetooth/wireless is fine for their own devices, but not for equipment in the music room.

- Pens, pencils, loose leaf, binders etc for all other high school courses might be required. This is depended on how the student uses their technology throughout the year.
