

On June 19th, Roger Melanson, MLA for Dieppe and Lewisville presented medals to students who achieved high ranking in a national mathematics competition at Lou MacNarin School. The school was awarded a Grade 3 prize for achieving the highest grade provincially. Of the 291 schools across Canada that participated in the grade 3 contest, Lou MacNarin ranked 31st. Subin, a grade 3 student ranked 24th out of 6701 competitors. In Canada, a total 477 schools participated in the grade 4 competition. At this grade level, Sunghyoun not only placed first at the school, he placed 1st provincially, and he tied for 1st place in Canada. Our grade 5 students, Emma and Onésime tied for first place at our school, ranking 248 out of 14 382 competitors.
