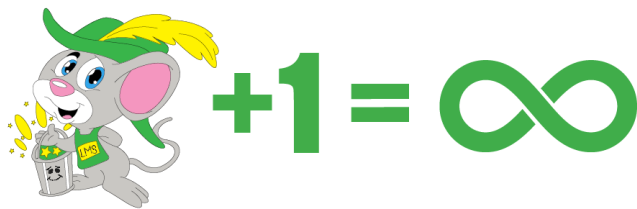


Updates from Lou MacNarin School- September 10, 2014
