Teacher Exam Guidelines

- 1. Subject teacher supervises their own exams.
- 2. Subject teacher retrieves the exams from the main office conference room.
- 3. Be in exam room 20 minutes prior to exam.
- 4. Separate desks and students.
- 5. No food or drink in exam room (water excluded).
- 6. Ensure all electronic devices are turned off and put away in book bags, coats, purses, then placed all together in a designated area of the classroom.
- 7. Teachers are required to provide paper for exam
- 8. Check attendance and if students are absent get a floater to relieve you to contact home. You know the particulars of a situation make the phone call.
- 9. During exam week make sure to check supplementary exam list in the main office and present theses exams to the Learning Commons supervisors prior to the writing date.
- 10. During exam time it is expected that teachers circulate the exam room.
- 11. Teacher's first priority is supervision.
- 12. Teachers should keep track of time remaining on the front white board.
- 13. Students must a minimum of 1 hour and work on the exam during this time.
- 14. Students are not permitted to leave the classroom during the exam without and escort. If you need an escort please use a floater or contact the office.
- 15. Students should physically hand in the exam to teachers not leave it on the desk.
- 16. Students should ensure they hand in all exam material including scratch paper. Nothing is handed in after they leave the exam room.
