School Code of Conduct 2015

1. School Safety: Students that violate or compromise the safety of the learning environment will be subject to in-school suspension, suspension, or law enforcement.
2. Student Entrance and doorways:
  - 2.1. All students and visitors must use the main entrance to enter the school during the instructional day.
    - 2.1.1. Special arrangements have been made for some students with particular needs.
  - 2.2. All doors must remain locked and closed. Propping or opening doors for students outside the building is prohibited.
  - 2.3. Students that are late for class must use the main entrance and sign into the building.
3. Wooded Areas/Forest and Green spaces
  - 3.1. Students are prohibited to be in or near the wooded areas that surround the school without the direct supervision/instruction of a teacher. Students may spend time in the green spaces in the quad weather permitting.
4. Stairways:
  - 4.1. Stairways are intended for movement between floors.
    - 4.1.1. Students are prohibited from eating, sitting or hanging out in stairwells.
5. Security System:
  - 5.1. Moncton High School is monitored by a camera system both inside and outside the building. Cameras may be used to identify, or prosecute offenders at any time – the system includes the parking lot and after hours monitoring.
  - 5.2. Students and staff must follow all posted signs to ensure the safety and security of all users.
6. Driving and Parking:
  - 6.1. School parking lots, and roadways are part of Moncton High School, and reserve the right to limit or deny parking.
    - 6.1.1. Students are NOT permitted to spend time in their car during instructional or non-instructional times including lunches and breaks.
    - 6.1.2. Students that are not following the rules of the road will be reported to the R.C.M.P. including Longfellow Dr., and Royal Oaks Blvd.

7. School Wifi, Electronic devices and Network:
  - 7.1. Students are responsible for the care and use of their electronic devices.
    - 7.1.1. You are responsible for the content that is sent or distributed from your username, and account. Do not share your password with anyone. All web content is monitored, with a firewall.
8. Drugs and Alcohol
  - 8.1. Drugs and Alcohol are prohibited during all school functions. If a student is suspected to be involved in/or around drugs or alcohol will be sent to administration – who may elect to call the RCMP.
  - 8.2. Students participating in extra-curricular activities will also be signing and following the Extra-Curricular Code of Conduct (APPENDIX A).
9. Tobacco Use
  - 9.1. Tobacco use is not permitted on school property in any form including vaporizers.
    - 9.1.1. Smoking is not to be promoted or endorsed, cigarettes or vaporizers are not to be seen in Moncton High School.
10. Property Damage
  - 10.1. Students are financially responsible for defacing, graffiti, or vandalism to school property including school desks, and will be expected to pay for any damage before returning to school.
  - 10.2. Property damage between automobiles in the parking lot must be dealt with through insurance providers, and/or RCMP.
11. Food and Cafeteria Services
  - 11.1. All meals must be eaten in the cafeteria. The only exception is if a teacher gives you permission to eat in their class.
  - 11.2. Students that are caught shoplifting, or stealing from the cafeteria may be prosecuted by the food provider, or by school administration.
  - 11.3. Bake sales, or fundraisers must be approved by student council, and cannot contain common allergens.
  - 11.4. Jackets and book bags are prohibited in the cafeteria line up.
12. Dress Code
  - 12.1. Moncton High School is an educational institution and appropriate attire is expected for all classes. (APPENDIX B)
  - 12.2. No hats or jackets are permitted in classes.

### 13. School Fees

13.1. All student/activity fees must be paid prior to participation. (APPENDIX C)

13.1.1. Student Council fees must be paid before attending school functions like dances, or coffee houses.

### 14. School Lockers

14.1. Classroom lockers are the rented property of Moncton High School and are subject to search and control of school officials.

14.1.1. Students must use the locker that has been assigned to them by their homeroom teacher.

14.1.2. All lockers must be locked with not in use.

14.1.3. Students should not share their combination with other students.

14.1.4. Students are responsible for the contents of their lockers.
