

Graduation Class Executive

A Royal's graduating year is an exciting time as we all celebrate the graduate's successes and accomplishments from all their years of school. To help all our graduates celebrate during their graduation year, a group of grade 12 students will be elected by their peers to serve as the graduation class executive. This executive group are leaders for the graduating class who have the responsibility to promote a spirit of class unity through different events and communication. The executive members will also work as a liaison between staff advisors and the rest of the graduation class. To fulfill these duties, executive members will need to be able to effectively collaborate with the teacher supervisors and other members of the executive, plan and run meetings and events, attend weekly meetings, complete correspondence, and communicate effectively.

To be eligible to serve as part of the graduation class executive, a student must:

- Be and remain eligible to graduate in June of 2021;
- Be and remain in good standing with the expectations of the Riverview High School community;
- Currently have and maintain a minimum average of at least 70%; and
- Have the recommendation of two teachers.

To be considered for the election of graduation class executive, you must submit an online form as your application by **3:45PM, Tuesday, November 10th**. In the online form, you will need to:

- include the names of two teachers who have agreed to provide a positive reference for you;
- outline the qualities you possess that will help you be a successful part of the executive; and
- include an outline (point form) of a speech you will record for your fellow graduates to review prior to voting.
