Dear Parents and Guardians:

Re: **CONFIRMED CASE OF COVID-19 AT RHS**

This is to inform you that a positive case of COVID-19 has been confirmed in your school. We are working with Public Health officials to identify any students and school personnel who may have been in contact with the virus. Under the new Red Phase guidelines, the school building will be closed for the next three (3) days and Distance Learning will take place for all students. We will be in contact with families on Sunday to tell you the plan for learning next week after we further consult with Public Health.

We understand you may feel anxious over the coming days. **Public Health officials will contact you if your child has been in close contact with the confirmed case and will tell you if your child needs to self-isolate. If you are not contacted by Public Health officials, your child can continue to attend school.**

It is natural to want to know if your child may have been exposed to the virus. Public Health officials will inform those who are at risk of the next steps, but to protect the privacy of students and school personnel, other details including names, will not be released.

Children and young people look to the adults in their lives to guide them on how to react to worrying and stressful events. Parents are encouraged to talk to their children about any anxieties and remind them to treat one another with kindness and respect, in person and on social media.


If your child is showing any symptoms of COVID-19, you should:

1. Register them online for a test by clicking "Get tested" on the GNB corona virus website (www.gnb.ca/coronavirus), or
2. Contact Tele-Care 811, or
3. Contact your primary care provider.

The 811 operators or your primary care provider will evaluate your child before sending them for testing.
