Below are a few important items and upcoming events:

<u>Hot Air Balloon Visit:</u> Sussex Balloon Fiesta is here, and we were so fortunate to have Brad and Stevie Armstrong and their crew from **Up We Go Balloon Quests** visit us with their balloon today! The children loved seeing the balloon basket and hearing the exciting information the pilots shared.

Fire Drill and Off-Site Evacuation Practice: As part of the AES Comprehensive Safety Plan, we are required to have a number of fire drill, lockdown and off-site evacuation practices. The purpose of these events is to ensure our children are safe and know what to do in case of an emergency. Each year, we explain to the children that we are moving to our safe space either inside or outside the building. We try to make this a comfortable event for children, but some still may feel nervous. We will always make you aware of the dates for our drills. I encourage you to have a conversation with your child(ren) the day before to reassure them this is a practice and there is nothing to worry about. We will have our first planned fire drill on Tuesday, Sept 12 and our Off-Site Evacuation (where we walk to Apohaqui Community Church with the help of an RCMP Officer) on Tuesday, Sept. 26.

<u>Student Information Forms:</u> Your child would have brought home a number of forms this week. We ask that you complete the Student Information Form, a Student Information and Photographs form, an Allergy form and a Computer Access form. Please be sure to complete the forms in full and sign in the required areas.

Student Fees: A reminder that student fees are due by the end of September. We ask all families to provide \$40 for each child. This fee covers the cost of their child(ren)'s school supplies. This fee can be paid using www.schoolCashOnline.com If you have not yet registered using this program, I would recommend doing so as this is our main platform for collecting school funds.

<u>Breakfast Club:</u> Eating breakfast each morning positively impacts a child's day. They have more concentration and more energy for the fun things that happen at school! Our wonderful Home & School Committee will begin hosting Breakfast Club on **Monday, Sept. 18**.
