

PLEASE PUT CHILD'S NAME ON EVERY ITEM WITH ASTERISK *

- 12+** good pencils --pre-sharpened is a greatly appreciated, huge plus! 😊
- 4 white erasers**, plastic removed
- 1 box of crayons, preferably 16 count
- *Small scissors, rounded-tip *
- ***4 large glue sticks** (or 6 small ones) *
- ***6+ dry erase markers** (decent quality, so they'll erase) & **1 yellow highlighter***
- ***1 package of 8-16 washable markers** (regular child-type broad-line, not fine tip)*
- ***1 pencil box**, standard size, + **1 small pencil case** (usually need both, 1 for markers)*
- 6 duo tangs** --**2 each of red, yellow** (or orange), **blue** (or purple, if 1st color not available)
- ***2-3 tubs Play-Doh*** (cheap brands dry up quick)
- *a clipboard (without folding cover—a plain, wooden one is fine)*
- 1 black Sharpie-type permanent marker**
- ***Sturdy headphones*** it's crucial these work well; pls be prepared to replace as needed
- Indoor sneakers** with non-marking soles* **-All footwear Velcro/no tie** please, unless child is very good at tying
- ***Spill-resistant water bottle, book bag, lunchbox*** --Send plastic cutlery/paper straws **as needed, if your child uses.**
- Complete change of clothes** in plastic/cloth bag, **name clearly marked on bag**
- 8 large** seal top Ziploc bags (for home agenda) plus **6 smaller sandwich-size zip-baggies** (for games, etc)
- 2 packs of unscented baby/hand wipes**; refills packs are fine
- 2-3 boxes Kleenex-type tissues** --Note: Rain coat, rain boots & splash pants will be needed
- Additional items if you wish to make a donation to the school: i.e stickers, craft supplies – please contact the teacher for items needed**

*Please remove plastic packaging & name-label each item marked with a * individually (including markers & lids, preferably). If you are unable to find exact items on the list, similar are usually sufficient
