- Grad March to Baccalaureate June 15^{th,} 5:45 p.m. SRHS
 Line up by 6:10 p.m. Don't forget to wear grad gowns and comfortable shoes. Grads will march from the school along the sidewalk to the Baccalaureate service. Families and community members will watch and cheer them on.
- **Baccalaureate Service** June 15^{th,} 7:00 p.m. Saunders Irving Chapel @ Kingwood University, 20 Wesley Drive. The Graduates may attend a 30-to-35-minute celebration service featuring music, readings by graduates and special guests. Family and community members are encouraged to attend.
- Prom Parade June 17^{th,} 5:45 p.m.
 Graduates attending the vehicle parade should be parked at the 8th Hussars by 5:45 pm to be a part of the parade. The 8th Hussars area will only be accessible for vehicles that will participate in the parade. Others are free to park offsite and walk in to take pictures. A group photo will be taken at 6:00 p.m. Followed by the parade. All students must arrive at the school by 7:45 p.m.
- **Prom** June 17^{th,} 8:00 -10:30 pm. SRHS Cost \$30/grad, \$35/non-grad (\$35/grad, \$40/guest after May 30th Graduates will be announced as they exit their vehicles, there will be a photo area set up at the side of the building where grads can get pictures with family and friends. Grads will do a final Grand March through the roped-off area at @7:45pm prior to entering SRHS for their Prom. Prom is for Graduates and dates only. Throughout the evening, there will be pizza, a candy bar, door prizes, and music in the beautifully decorated cafeteria, lobby area, and courtyard. There will be multiple photo walls with students available to take photos all evening. Our 2025 SRHS Valedictorian and Salutatorian will be announced during this event.
- Graduation rehearsal June 19th 10:00 a.m. 8th Hussars Sports Centre. Students will be shown how to enter the rink, receive their diploma and practice the process. It is very important that all grads attend so that they are aware of the details of the graduation night process. It is at this time that extra floor tickets will be handed out to graduates.
- Graduation June 19th 7:00 p.m. 8th Hussars Sports Centre.
 Once grad fees are paid, each graduate will receive their cap and gown and 4-floor tickets prior to graduation week. A ticket is not required for bleacher seating. Graduates should arrive at the school by 6:15 p.m. Dress is formal for graduation.
- Safe Grad June 19th 9:30 p.m. Cost \$20/grad (\$30/grad after May 30th) Safe Grad will follow shortly after the graduation ceremony. Students should arrive at the high school between 9:00pm-9:30pm for pizza, snacks, and games before heading to Moncton. Bags will be checked prior to boarding the buses. Safe Grad 2025 is heading to Moncton. Our first stop will be at the Moncton Bowlarama & Arcade where students will bowl, play arcade games, and have pop and snacks. Following this student will be bused to the Moncton Sports Dome where they can partake in Laser Tag, Inflatable Games, and Indoor Sports of a large variety. Students will then be bused back to SRHS for pick up at 6:30am. We are looking forward to this allnighter with no napping as there is too much fun to be had. ^(C)
