Why?

Ellen Watters was an SRHS graduate who went on to become a competitive cyclist. She was tragically killed while out for a training ride in Sussex in December, 2016. Ellen was the epitome of hard work, grit, determination, and camaraderie. A self-taught cyclist with big dreams, she stopped at nothing to succeed in the sport. Along the way, she inspired people of all ages and skill levels to better themselves and the world around them. What?

3. FINANCIAL NEED /5 points

Please describe your particular circumstances regarding financial need and the impact the bursary will have on your situation.

4. ACCOMPLISHMENTS (Athletic, Personal, Community - Anything) /4 points

Tell us what you've done that makes you proud.

5. COMMUNITY INVOLVEMENT /5 points

Any volunteering or involvement with your community?

6. INCLUSION /5 points

Tell us about a time that you made sure someone on the outside felt included. What did you do and what was the outcome?
