General Regulations:

- 1. All applicants, to be eligible for the aforementioned scholarships must meet the entrance requirements of the school to which they are applying.
- 2. Applicants must be residents of the Province of New Brunswick at the time of submission of application.

- 4. All applications must be accompanied by an <u>official transcript of</u> marks and a letter from the applicant.
- 5. Closing date for submission of applications will be MARCH 31st of each year.
