At the start of Semester II, all High School students in ASD-South will be attending school on an A/B rotation. This is a positive change for our students as it allows them in be in the building every other day (no one group will come two days in a row again). This also means that if there is a storm day, the group that should have attended that day will come to school the next day.

Attending school, both in-person and at-home every day is essential for our Province's Blended Learning Model to be effective during this time of Covid-19. Being present means actively participating in the learning. Another change across our District will be that all high school students will be coded as P (present), rather than as DL on their home learning days (distance learning) for all classes that students are engaged in learning.

# FINAL ASSESSMENT WEEK: JANUARY 22-29

Our Exam/ Assessment Week will look differently this year, but some things will remain business as usual.

The Bus Schedule stays the same during this time, but the bell schedule will be adjusted as Assessments will be written from 8:45am—10:15am and 12:30pm—2:00pm. There will be two assessments per day (morning and afternoon). Students will only attend on the day that they have assessment(s).
