The Summer School program is offered to students of School District 6 and neighbouring districts. To enroll in Summer School, a student must have permission of his/her school Principal. In addition, students enrolled in summer school need a minimum mark during the school year of 50%.

COURSES:

Students may enroll one or both courses.

FEES:

The tuition fees for Grade 9, 10, 11, 12 English, Science and/or Math - \$200 for each course. Money orders should be made out to Sussex Regional High School.

DAILY SCHEDULE: To be determined

REFUNDS:

A full refund of tutition fees will be issued by July 2nd if:

- Summer School is cancelled due to lack of registrations.
- A student cannot be timetabled.
- The course/courses in which a student has registered cannot be offered due to lack of registrations.
