Principal's Report:

- Lori-Ann presented some slides as an update to the PBIS (Positive Behavior Intervention and Support) that had been presented to the committee by John Tingley during the November 5th meeting. 5 new teachers will be required for grades 9 & 10 to participate in class visits and book studies.
- The SIP (School Improvement Plan) was presented to the committee. The goals of the SIP:
 - 1. Reduce bullying incidents by 25% Statistics have been recorded from last year and this year to be used for calculating this metric.
 - By June 2025 have a plan to reduce student presence in hallways, lobby and washrooms. The PBIS can contribute to this plan with the Tier 1 Behavior support. Bathroom sign-outs are in place now and data will be collected to be used for calculating progress.
- PISA (Programme for International Student Assessment) was also presented to the committee. PISA tests the skills and knowledge of 15-year-old students. 40 students will be randomly selected to take the tests. The results of this testing affect department level decisions regarding math, reading, and science.

• [CONFIDENTIAL] School Calendar pilot was introduced to the committee. The pilot is about increasing the number of professional development days educators receive throughout the year.

4. New Business

 Andrea talked about the upcoming DEC (District Education Council) Symposium in Fredericton, NB May 30th and 31st. PSSC members are invited. There is space for 6-8 members.  The committee discussed some items that need to be considered for the School calendar pilot. If more days off are added, things like child care, child safety, and public perception (to name a few) need to be addressed.
