## CREDIT SYSTEM

All grade II and I2 all courses are given a value of I credit each.
We have two semesters each year, and 5 courses offered each semester.
Between grades II and I2 there is the opportunity to get $\mathbf{2 0}$ regular credits.

In grade I0, you have your first opportunity for a credit towards graduation from your second semester math class (NRF 10 or Financial And Workplace Math IIO).

## COURSE LEVELS

The first two numbers indicate the grade and the last number indicates the level. Many students will take grade II courses in grade $\mathbf{I} 2$ and vice versa.

Open or "O" courses are offered at one level only.
Ex: Agriculture IIO, Ind. Family Dynamics 120
Level I are enriched university preparatory.
Ex: English III, Physics I2I
Level 2 are academic/university/college preparatory.
Ex: Music II2, Biology I22
Level 3 are general/college preparatory.
Ex: Modern History I I3, English I23
