

## Language Arts

Suggested learning activities for the week:

1. Read for 30 minutes each day – you can read books/articles you have at home or read something online. There are some reading sites on the [school website](#) under the language arts section.
2. Use the [Writing Reading Responses](#) sheet to help you write a response to something you read once a week. Or complete an activity from the [Independent reading activity](#) sheet.
3. Read the article that is in your grade level section and complete the activity that is included with it.

OR

Go to the [Scholastic Learn at Home](#) page and work on the activities for Week 2. Here is some helpful information for navigating the site:

- Select your grade level section (it's okay to select a section lower than the students current grade level if the student is reading it independently)
  - Select [Week 2](#)
  - Scroll down the page a bit until you see [Daily reading quest](#) (under the Week 2 heading)
    - The daily reading quest is a collection of activities that students can choose to complete after they have read an article.
  - There are 5 days of articles to explore in each week.
4. [April journal prompts](#) – choose a topic to write about and challenge yourself to write as much as you can about it.
