Driver Responsibilities

- Driver is to be familiar with Policy 701 and, if they will be alone with students, there
 must be a Criminal Record Check on file.
- Driver must be at least 21 years of age, in good health, and hold a valid driver's license of the appropriate class for the vehicle being driven.
- Mandatory \$1,000,000 liability insurance coverage.
- Vehicle's insurer to be notified that students will be transported from time to time.
- Have winter tires on the vehicle from October 15 to April 30 each year.
- Driver is to exercise mature driving judgment, especially during poor weather and visibility conditions.
- Vehicle's valid safety inspection sticker must be properly displayed.
- Vehicle's seat belts are to be used.
- Luggage is to be securely stored, so not to obstruct vision or block aisles and exit doors.
- Driver is to have with them emergency phone numbers, including the number where the principal or designate can be reached.
- A cell phone or other communication device is recommended.
- Drivers is not to drive when tired or unable to function at normal levels of efficiency.
- Driver is not to consume any alcoholic beverages or be under the influence of other drugs or medication which could impair driving.
- Driver and passengers are not to smoke in the vehicle.
- Vehicle's headlights are required to be on when students are on board.
