Graduation Memo #1 – February 2024

Greetings to the Class of 2024,

We are writing today with the initial details for our Graduation Ceremony so that families can plan for Graduation. The memo addresses the following:

Valedictorian Selection Process

On Thursday June 20, 2024, we will be hosting a traditional graduation ceremony in the RHS Gymnasium.

Key Dates for Ceremony & Planning:

Wednesday, June 19 – Mandatory Grad Rehearsal and Grad Ticket Pick-up 11:00

Thursday, June 20 - Graduation Ceremony, RHS Gymnasium 2:00

Grad Fees – Payable via Cashless Schools

Your Grad Fee is structured as follows:

Grad ceremony-\$70 (covers cap, gown, diploma, gym set-up, reception, photographer)

*Prom and Safe Grad are not included in this fee. They are being organized by a parent committee and information will follow. (June 17th)

Selection of Valedictorian and calculation of Honour Standing.

Honour Standing for Graduating Students – Distinction = 95% and above High Honours =90-94.9% & higher, Honours =85%-89.9%.

Honour standing for graduates from Rothesay High School will be determined as follows:

A student will be registered in a full course of study in their graduating year unless they are on a pre-approved academic plan in place by administration.

Only courses taken in the graduating year will be counted for Honours.

In calculating the average, English 12 must be counted.

Of the other courses the lowest mark will be dropped. If a student has INC, they will not be eligible.

To determine honours, the sum of the marks on the courses counted (English to be included) will be divided by one less than number of courses taken.

A 1% bonus will be applied to the calculated average for each Level 1 course, and Advanced Placement (AP) course.

The Valedictorian will be the student with the highest average after all bonuses are applied.
