School leaders around North America are resetting behavioural expectations in school buildings since the loosening of Public Health directives and we are no different here in the NEST. This week we are pushing the RESET button with some clarity around what it means to be a RedHawk.


Students will be reminded that RedHawks do the following.

- 1. I will attend all my classes on a regular and punctual basis. This will include all assemblies and Homeroom Periods.
- 2. I will be prepared for all my classes by bringing with me all necessary materials and will work to the best of my ability.
- 3. I will make a real and sustained effort in all my classes by participating in class, completing all assignments.
- 4. I will always show proper courtesy and respect for the teachers and students.
- 5. I will conduct myself in a manner the promotes a positive learning environment.
- I will follow all school policies and rules as well as all reasonable directions of the administration and the staff.

Of specific focus over the last 50 days of classes are.

- 1. Cellphones must be away, in the cell hotel or in bookbags, for a minimum of the first 30 minutes. They may only be used with express permission of the teacher.
- Only one person may leave the classroom at a time, and they must leave their cellphone behind. They should be gone for a reasonable amount of time. Students will be given notes if they have permission to be out of class.
- 3. Students must work in their assigned classrooms and may not work in alternate spaces without prior arrangements.
