## **Getting Ready for a Full Nest!**

On Monday April 12, the beginning of the 4<sup>th</sup> quarter of school, all students will return to full time attendance and in-person learning. On Tuesday March 23 RHS staff were given the opportunity to receive a vaccination and we were given the day to prepare for the return of all students to full time attendance. 

## Class of 2022 (Grade 11) – IMPORTANT!

April 1, 2021 marks the first day that current grade 11 students can apply for entry to NBCC (New Brunswick Community College) for September 2022. Students can secure a spot on the waiting list for their program of choice beginning on Thursday. NBCC fills their programs on a FIRST COME, FIRST SERVED basis and as a result some waiting lists can be upwards of 2 or 3 years long. There are three steps required to apply.

- 1) apply at NBCC.ca
- 2)request that a transcript be sent to NBCC by e-mailing <a href="Lydia.Smit@nbed.nb.ca">Lydia.Smit@nbed.nb.ca</a> or completing a form at the RHS Main Office 3) paying the application fee.

\*NOTE: If you are currently in Grade 12 and have no applied yet to your program of choice you should do so before Thursday to ensure you are not behind the many grade 11s's that will be applying province wide.






**COURSE SELECTION** – Only 25% of students have completed their course selection for 2021-2022 school year thus far and the deadline is Friday April 2. Parents & Guardians are asked to sit with their students and complete the process by following the steps below.

- Go to PowerSchool Public Portal (Same place you view grades/attendance)
- Select Class Registration tab
- Click on the pencil icons for each section of the course selection process and select the appropriate courses. Please note.
  - English 9, 10, 11 have been split in to two courses A & B (please select both courses)
  - o French Immersion Students should select FI courses.
  - There are sometimes multiple pages of choices, be sure to view all of them.
- Once all selections have been made (10 courses and 2 alternates) press SUBMIT (located on the Bottom Right-Hand Corner)
