Teachers will schedule meetings on TEAMS for each class.


- Teachers will spend between 20 -30 minutes direct teaching their students.
- The remainder of the time the call will remain open while the students complete tasks/assignments/assessments so they may ask questions. Some of this work may occur offline to limit screen time.
 Please Note: Teachers may group students into "breakout rooms" for small group work or even plan individual conferences for reassessment purposes.

Attendance: Students who login on schedule and remain engaged in learning will be marked DL (Distance Learning) while those who do not login and engage in learning will be marked UA (Unexcused Absence)
