Prospective Scholarship Recipient,

The Saint John Art Club Ltd has a long and vital history in the port city. The club was established initially as a branch of the Women's Art Association of Canada in 1896 and was later incorporated in 1908 by an Act of Parliament, inviting both men and women into membership. It is the oldest continuing art club in Canada and aims to advance the knowledge and love of art and education.

In order to reach club objectives, each year we endeavor to encourage and assist young artists from the Saint John and surrounding area, who have an interest and aptitude to pursue post-secondary education in the field of fine arts, specifically painting and drawing. To this end we offer a \$1,000.00 scholarship to grade 12 students accepted into an accredited art program commencing Sept. 2016. The scholarship is awarded through an application process. A selection committee reviews applicants' submissions and selects the one(s) which they believe best suits the objectives of the scholarship program. The prospective recipient must submit the following to be considered:

- **Application form**
- **Artist profile**
- **Art portfolio (CD submission or original work properly wrapped for protection)**
- **Teacher recommendation**
- **Copy of letter of acceptance from the post-secondary institution you will be attending**
