Attendance Policy

Please call 847-6204 if your student is home sick or has an appt – it will prevent many of the steps below.

1. Every time a student misses a class you will receive a call from the auto-dialer informing you of the period missed. (While a very small percentage of these are mistakes 99.9% are correct – please contact the teacher to verify)
2. At 5 classes missed you will get a call from your Homeroom Teacher to see if assistance is required.
3. At 10 days missed you will get a call from the VP, Mr. Peters to see if Assistance is required.
4. At 15 days you will be asked to attend a meeting to discuss what more can be done to improve attendance
5. At 20 days you are likely to either be removed from the class or will receive an Incomplete in the course.
6. Any student receiving an INC in a course or who misses 20 or more homeroom classes will not be eligible for high honours/honours or valedictorian.
