First Day & School Supplies

1. **SCHOOL PHOTOS** – Students will have their student ID and school photos taken on their first day of school. Students should dress accordingly. Our provider is Photography Flewelling. (Ad on Page 3)
2. **HOMEROOM.** Students will meet with their Homeroom teacher for a portion of the morning while we assign lockers, outline course change procedure, and gather paperwork that is to be sent home.
3. **SCHEDULES.** We will be working on Timetables throughout the week and will do our best to fill the schedules with everything that a student wants. Sometimes scheduling brings hard choices and when that happens, we prioritise what is required for graduation & post-secondary planning.
4. **SCHOOL SUPPLIES & FEES** – With laptops being the primary method for work submission and organization students will need limited school supplies.
