Practice Evacuation Wednesday Dec. 14 - On Wednesday we will be practicing our evacuation plan. A real evacuation would occur when it is deemed unsafe to enter the building and we have to relocate the staff and students to an alternate location. Our location is the Lady of Perpetual Hope Church on Almon Lane. On Wednesday, we will be evacuating the building and walking the students to the church so they are aware of the procedure and location.

Practice Lockdown procedure Dec. 20 - We will also be practicing our lockdown procedure. In the event of an imminent threat within the building, it is important that we have a procedure in place to protect students and staff to the best of our ability. Our school's lockdown procedure is designed for the event that such a situation occurs. It is important that all students and staff members are aware of the signal which will be used to indicate that a lockdown is being undertaken as well as an understanding of how each of us is to respond in such cases.

This practice session will occur on December 20th.

My Blue Print Training in HR - On Dec. 14th, all students will be trained on My Blue Print. This is a career planning website that will be crucial to assist students when choosing their courses. For our current grade 9 students and the students to follow, their student profiles will also be a graduation requirement when they reach grade 12. Please remind your student to bring their device on Wednesday. This training will occur during homeroom and we will have an alternate schedule due to this event.

Cabaret—the winter dance is on Wednesday December 14th from 6:30—9:30pm. They will need to have their student ID. The tickets are on sale on Cashless schools for \$15. These must be purchased in advance.

A couple of notes regarding the dance:
