

Harry Miller Middle School Dress Code

Students attending Harry Miller Middle School are expected to wear appropriate school clothing. This may not necessarily be in keeping with today's fashions, however, everyone (students and staff) are expected to dress sensibly and modestly. What might be appropriate dress for the beach is not always appropriate for school. Keeping this in mind, the following will hopefully clarify any questions:

1. Tops must have backs as well as fronts and sleeves to cover undergarments.
2. Shorts and skirts are to be of length no shorter than 2 inches above the knee.
3. Trousers are to be worn properly fastened at the waist to ensure that undergarments do not show.
4. We thank you in advance for removing all hats and headbands upon entering the school.
5. Students are not to show any bare midriff or wear low-cut tops.
6. Pajamas and leisure pants are not acceptable attire at school.
7. Clothing that carries offensive slogans or ads for alcohol or drugs is not permitted.
