Ongoing Committees/Programs

PSSC: Parents/Guardians of HMMS students can be a part of the Parent School Support Committee. The Principal and teacher representatives are members of the committee, but family members are the Chairpersons, Secretary and integral members of the Committee. The District Education Council (DEC) member also attends, when possible. There is a PSSC Orientation session at Hampton Middle School on September 25th in the evening. Time commitment: Monthly meeting

Library: We require three library volunteers (Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday) and replacements for the school year. Our Library Assistant, Mrs. Nancy Long, is able to assist with training, if required. Time frame is over our lunch hour and could be for the whole year or in part. Time commitment: Weekly

Coaching/Assistant Coaching: Junior Varsity (JV) and Varsity (V) teams throughout the school year: Cross country, golf club, soccer, basketball, volleyball, track and field. You work in collaboration with our Athletic Director (AD), Mrs. Cheryl Throop. Time Commitment: Varies

Phys Ed class clinics: (Lacrosse, Ultimate Frisbee, Ringette)- If you have particular interest/hobby or sport that you are actively involved in and would like to share with our PE classes, contact Mrs. Cheryl Throop (Cheryl.throop@nbed.nb.ca) Time Commitment: Varies

Enrichment- During the school year we love to be able to offer times for staff or volunteers to work with smaller groups of students on a special activity/hobby/initiative, etc. Time commitment: Varies

Fundraising—We would like interested family members to assist us in forming a Fundraising Committee for HMMS. If you would be interested in this, please let us know and we would love some new ideas and faces to assist. Thanks! Time commitment : Varies

Gardening/Outdoor Beautification (Fall and Spring) Our staff and students embark on a school wide clean up, typically two times a year. We weed, rake, sweep, add mulch to the flower beds and tidy up our “The Bear Cave”. There is more we could do with added support in the fall and spring months. Time commitment: Seasonally

Chaperones (as per “Social” schedule) There are approximately 4 socials per year. Schedule will be determined at the start of the school year. Time commitment: 1-4 times as per your schedule of availability

Special Events

Book Fair (November 19-22, 2019): Scholastic Book Fairs can be organized and held in our school library on the Wednesday, Thursday and Fridays of the week in which parent teacher conferences are held. Students would be able to visit the fair during school hours as well, if volunteers are available to assist. This can potentially take place two times during the school year. Time commitment: Once per year

Christmas Dinner (December) - Each year prior to the holiday break the cafeteria offers a lunch special which is a special turkey dinner with all the “fixin’s”! Staff and family members serve the students their dinners over the noon hour. Time commitment: Once per year

HMMS Santa’s Workshop (December) - Santa’s Elves will be busy and will still need your help to price items, set up the workshop, and oversee the buying of items by the students. The workshop will run over the course of a week . Time commitment:: Varies, as per your availability and role

Staff Appreciation (February) - Staff Appreciation is held provincially in February. Our staff greatly appreciates the treats and recognition received by the students and families who are able to assist. Time commitment: Once per year

Talk With Our Kids About Money (TWOKAM) (April 15th, 2020) - This event is held each year in April. We would love to have three guest speakers (one per grade level) to present a topic related to finances, savings, investments, bank accounts, etc. This has been a very positive experience for our students and we hope to continue this school year. We would also like to offer an enrichment opportunity for students with this event as well. Time commitment: Once per year

Spring Fling (May) - We would love to have unique ideas and people to help organize and run a “Spring Fling” filled with activities taking place in our school and outside in the larger community. We know that our students love to try new things so what better time than spring! Time commitment: Once per year
