- School Sport Canada National Jersey Day is Thursday, Nov. 17<sup>th</sup>. We
  encourage students and staff to show their love and support for sport by
  wearing a sport jersey to school, work, or play.
- We are huge proponents of outdoor learning and being active and love that our children engage in a variety of activities during outdoor play time. On any given day you would find children playing soccer, basketball, wallball, building forts in the woods, playing on Dreamland, participating in sidewalk games, and exploring freely on the playground. Until recently we had no problem with children bringing their own soccer balls, basketballs, or tennis balls for wall ball. In some instances, what started to occur is that the owner of the ball (brought from home) was determining who was permitted to play. Given that we have one soccer area for each grade level (gr. 2-5) we needed to ensure that all students interested in playing were welcomed to play. By using school equipment, we were able to eliminate the sense of ownership that some children demonstrated when using their own ball. We explained to the children that they could continue to bring their own balls to use in small groups, but school balls would be utilized on our soccer and basketball fields to ensure everyone could participate. When parents/guardians have questions or concerns regarding decisions we make, I ask that you reach out to us for clarification, rather than expressing your frustrations about F.E.S. on social media. We welcome your feedback and are always willing to discuss concerns you may have.
- Our Kick-Off to Kindergarten session will take place on Thursday at 7pm. This meeting will provide parents and guardians with an opportunity to learn more about the Transition to School program and the planned activities and events throughout the pre-school year. There will be suggestions of activities that could be done at home and other information to encourage your child's learning, as he/she gets ready to begin school in September 2023.
