Kindergarten attendance is compulsory for all children who reach the age of five years on or before December 31st, 2020. Requirements for registration are:

- proof of age: birth certificate, passport, another piece of ID (e.g. immigration documents or a certificate issued by another Canadian Provincial Government indicating the date of birth)
- proof of Immunization
