- All students will come directly into the building when they arrive on the first day. Students will go to their classes where teachers will be waiting to greet them. Specialist teachers will be available to assist in the lobby and will work as tour guides. We have designated educational assistants and student teachers to take our kindergarten children to the classes in small groups.

- Please find attached information on Safe Arrival. With SafeArrival, you are asked to report your child's absence in advance using any of these three convenient methods:
 - 1. Using your mobile device, download and install the SchoolMessenger app from the Apple App Store or the Google Play Store (or from the links at https://go.schoolmessenger.ca). The first time you use the app, select Sign Up to create your account (use the email address you have on file with the school). Select Attendance then Report an Absence.
 - 2. Use the SafeArrival website, https://go.schoolmessenger.ca. The first time you use the website, select Sign Up to create your account. Select Attendance then Report an Absence.
 - 3. Call the toll-free number 1-833-219-9065 to report an absence using the automated phone system.
 - These options are available 24 hours/day, 7 days a week. Future absences can be reported at any time.
- A reminder to subscribe to the **Bus Planner Parent Portal** to receive notifications specific to your child's bus service. The direct link to this service is https://bp.nbed.nb.ca/asds. In order to set up "My Children", you will require your child's student ID number, which is available from your child's teacher or from Mrs. Cowan by calling the school.
- Photography Flewwelling will be here on Thursday, September 12th for school photos. For best results, they suggest clothing that is free of large logos and busy designs. Retakes will be taken on Monday, September 23rd.
- We will use https://fairvale.hotlunches.net for lunch orders again this year. If you already have an account, please update with appropriate teacher names. If you do not have an account, please sign up. Ordering for Food Period #1opens on Wednesday, September 4th and closes Wednesday Sept. 11th. You will be able to place orders, make online payments, and receive email notifications and remiders when a new food period is about to begin. The system is a Canadian-based site developed in BC, and is widely used in schools across Canada.
