- If your child tests positive for COVID, please do the following:

• An important reminder that families are not permitted to use the designated bus lane from 7:40-8:15. Please remember that our supervision team is outside to greet our children from 7:40-8:05 only. If children are dropped off after that time, they will need to make their way into the school on their own and check in at the office. We understand that more families are opting to drive children to school and recognize that it can be congested at times. We appreciate your patience and cooperation as our children's safety is of utmost importance.
