

Canada Career Week November 18th-22

- **Month of November**

November is "Career Month" at Quispamsis Elementary School and our staff has been invited to think back to their pre-education days and submit a sentence or two that provides clues about a former job. These clues are being read on the morning announcements and students are invited to guess what the job is and who might have had that job. The answers are provided later in the day. This is not intended as a formal contest, but simply to raise awareness about a variety of careers and employment options.

Ms. Casey will visit each K-2 class to introduce Habit #2- "*Begin with the End in Mind: Have a Plan*" and link this habit to career exploration. Likewise, Ms. Casey will visit grades 3, 4 and 5 classes where she will introduce habit #2, in addition to introducing the theme of entrepreneurship and its connection to our October and November Habits- "*Be Proactive*" and "*Begin with the End in Mind*". Following Ms. Casey's visit to the grade 3-5 classes, she will ask students to complete a worksheet activity in which they will practice beginning with the end in mind, by creating a business and outlining 3 steps they will need to take in order to achieve their entrepreneurial goal.

Grade 3: Our four grade 3 classes will be combined into two groups and each group will hear two speakers. Grades 4 & 5: The grade 4 and 5 classes will be combined into groups of 32 students. Each student will be able to select three speakers from a pool of five speakers. Each speaker will present for 25 minutes, with 5 minutes to switch between sessions. The theme for the grades 4 and 5s is: Knowing Yourself and Finding Your Passion. Presenters will be asked to make connections to our habits "Be Proactive" and "Begin with the End in Mind".
