6.1 2nd Annual Fun Run Update

6.2 Outdoor basketball net install and pavement stencils

The school already has 2 basketball nets that can be installed on the brickwork outside of the kindergarten wing. This was discussed in the spring of last year, and the district had expressed that they would do it. Currently there is masonry work going on at the school, Kelly B to inquire about installation of nets. If district not available to do, there is someone else who has volunteered that we can outsource.

Hillary W. has obtained stencils from the district, as well as paint. She will look into when is the optimum time to do this. Volunteers may be needed.
