	 Attendance review. Graph presented of attendance data from Sept 8- present. By week 3, many kids out, may be from colds, waiting for testing and exhaustion. 5-10 absences per day is an average. No letters this year being sent for missed days. We are having children missing less time than compared to last year. The hope is that the increased handwashing, wearing of masks and more outdoor and physical time will decrease the overall absences.

Behaviors Update

- Skills streaming ongoing- Kids are picking up on this quickly.
- Kids were struggling how to play with one another in their class bubble. But now, they are
 doing better with this. Several teachers have embraced that no kids are being left out. They
 are finding ways to engage each other.
- Nov-Dec- Friendship making skills
- Teachers are finding that there is no options to send to principal or make it right.

Budget Report:

Mrs. Blanchard

- District Operating Budget- Money was not taken away for March-June. New copiers bought for district initiative. 50% of budget goes to copying and machines. No limits on copies
- 100 per teacher allocated for Tech fund. Item for delivering online learning. Many purchased drawing type tablets. Some got cameras.
- School raised funds- Kids are skating now, kids can only go with one class at a time (rental
 of ice time). Kids will each go every second week for total of 5 times. Health nurses have
 established that only one parent, the same one, has to go every week. Not a school
 developed policy, strictly for Covid-19 precautions.
- Rest of money from student fees is for teachers to purchase things for classroom
- PSSC monies are typically \$675 or so. Last year items were purchased for classroom. Parent resource books have been purchased.
- School would like to develop a Zones of Regulation Room in the old district office. Match the colors to each zone.

Motion put forward to allow the school for Lindsay to put together list of Sensory Items for room. Passed by group.

Breakfast Program:

- Teachers are continuing to operate this program in their classrooms. They are now making oatmeal, bagels and toast for kids.
- December newsletter to do a breakfast drive for HES. Request for snacks, cereal, oatmeal, bagels.

Grants:

 Our grade 4 PLC has applied for an NBTA Teacher Grant (\$1500) for a specific literacy initiative

Home and School Report:

- No current fundraising, no spending happening.
- Teachers now have \$200 to spend on their classrooms.

Immunization Update:

43 students with incomplete; 2 student exempt.

Safety Procedures:

- Covid-19 Operational Plan and changes

- Safety procedures on going: Fire drills (6 per year), secure the building, lock down and evacuation.
- Fire drills done Sept. 15 and Oct 2. The second one was under a minute.
- Secure the building/ lockdown drill completed Sept. 24th.
- Emergency evacuation process is on hold due to Covid-19 and need to socially distance.
