	been changed to for simplicity and now includes 4 goals. The SIP and DIP do align. The				
	school will participate in a Pilot Review Program.				
	2020-2021 Enrollment:				
	 293 students enrolled with 16 classrooms. Enrollment in 2019-20 was 303 and in 2018-19 272.
