

Risk Mitigation Tool for schools operating during the COVID-19 Pandemic



Objective: This tool will assist schools to assess risks during the coronavirus disease (COVID-19) pandemic.

Directions:

Answer each question 1-by-1 by selecting the Risk Level of *low, medium, high, or N/A* (*before any controls are in place*) from the drop down list in column 1. It is *recommended* to complete this as a group so there are views from more than one person on whether an item is *low=med-high*.

Utilize your schools Operational Plan to outline the controls put in place to manage the risks identified. Select Yes-No/N/A from column 2 to identify controls have been included in your plan.

Use column 3 to then select *low, medium, high, or N/A* to identify that the risk has been controlled, and therefore creating a lower level of risk.

GENERAL				
What is the risk if unable to physically distance:				
when outside of the building (<i>exiting busses, recess</i>)	Medium	Yes	Low	Students will wear a mask upon exiting the bus/car. Students driven will not exit the car until the drop off spot is reached. They will keep the masks on while entering the front entrance until they enter their class. Lunch recess will be staggered to allow one class per area. There will be no morning outside recess or whole school morning recess. Dismissal will be done bus by bus. When a student's bus is called, they will put on their mask before entering the hall and keep it on until in the bus/car. Students being driven will be called when the buses leave. Parents will be asked to socially distance if picking children up.
when inside of the building (<i>classrooms, hallways, coat hooks, gym</i>)	High	Yes	Low	Within our classes, children move freely within their bubble. Phys ed. will be outside unless the weather prohibits. If phys. ed. is outside, teachers will deliver their class and exit the playground doors by the bathrooms or their own classroom door when applicable. All classes will enter the doors by the resource office. In the gym, the classes will enter one door at the corner of "Responsibility Row" and "Safe Passage" and exit the door by "Kindness Way" and "Responsibility Row". Children will not wear masks in the halls with whole class as schedules have been made to avoid meeting other bubbles in the hallways. All children/adults will wear a mask when not walking in their bubble in the hallways. Teachers in portables will coordinate times to be at their coat hooks to avoid congestion in the portable hallway.
while in entrance/exit doorways	High	Yes	Low	Everyone will wear masks when not with bubble.
when using narrow hallways	High	Yes	Low	Everyone will wear masks. Traffic in the main area of school will be on the blue lines. Arrows will indicate which direction traffic flows on the lines (right side).
when using narrow stairways	N/A	Yes	Low	
when using furniture	Medium	Yes	Low	Will be cleaned according to Standard Cleaning and Disinfecting Guidelines. When furniture is used for more than one class, it will be sanitized between uses.
when inside washrooms	High	Yes	Low	In washrooms with more than one stall, students/adults will wear masks. All will be instructed to wash as per guidelines and sanitize hands when returned to class. Bathrooms will be cleaned as per the guidelines.
What is the risk if the public/visitors are able to freely access the building?	High	Yes	Low	Doors will be locked at all times once classes begin. Appointments will be made when possible. Visitors will follow Visitor Guidelines (posted on door and website).
What is the risk if unable to track persons who have been in the school?	High	Yes	Low	Every visitor will be required to sign in with contact information.
What is the risk if applicable persons do not learn the school specific physical distancing requirements? (<i>students, staff, visitors, contractors, etc.</i>)	High	Yes	Low	Everyone will be required to wear a mask in common areas (hallways, bathrooms). People in their own bubble are not required to wear mask.
What is the risk if frequently touched surfaces are not being cleaned adequately? (<i>counters, door knobs, phones, common area pens</i>)	High	Yes	Low	Will be cleaned according to provincial cleaning and disinfecting guidelines.
What is the risk if there are not enough washrooms in the building?	Medium	Yes	Low	Will be cleaned according to provincial cleaning and disinfecting guidelines. Everyone will wear masks when in common washrooms. Hand sanitizer will be readily available.
What is the risk if common areas are not being cleaned adequately? (<i>washrooms, classrooms, science, art, library, cafeteria, etc.</i>)	High	Yes	Low	Will be cleaned according to provincial cleaning and disinfecting guidelines.
What is the risk if soap, water, and paper towels is not available?	High	Yes	Low	Custodians will check washrooms as per guidelines and replenished accordingly.
What is the risk if hand sanitizer is not available?	High	Yes	Low	District will provide hand sanitizer in each classroom and entrance to school. Parents will be permitted to send in unscented hand sanitizer.
What is the risk if adequate ventilation is not possible?	High	Yes	Low	Ventilation systems have been checked. Windows will be kept open when weather permits. Outdoor learning will be encouraged. Specialties will be outside as much as possible.
SCREENING				
What is the risk if persons are not aware of the need to stay home if feeling ill or have symptoms of COVID-19?	High	Yes	Low	Parents will adhere to guidelines of when to keep children home. Staff will self-monitor for symptoms and stay home according to Return to School document. Screening questions will be posted on front entrance doors and any visitors will be asked by administrative assistive if they have answered the screening questions.
What is the risk if persons are not aware of what to do if not feeling well while at the school?	High	Yes	Low	Visitors will follow the visitor plan that they have reviewed when entering school. Staff will watch for symptoms/student disclosure and call parents if necessary. Protocols will be followed as per Return to School guidelines. All persons with symptoms will be masked, leave building as soon as possible or put in isolation if not able to leave immediately.
What is the risk of not separating sick children from others? (<i>isolation room, space, or area</i>)	High	Yes	Low	As soon as symptoms appear, medical masks will be put on child. Student will be taken to isolation. Front room (chill room) will be designated as isolation area.
VULNERABLE POPULATION				
What is the risk if persons with a compromised immune system, chronic medical condition, or are over the age of 65 enter the building, and Operational Plan elements are not in place? (<i>Refer to Policy 704 for students</i>)	High	Yes	Low	Staff have self-identified as being vulnerable. Parents will identify their children and keep home as per their discretion.
PERSONAL PREVENTATIVE PRACTICES				
What is the risk if people are unaware of proper handwashing/hand hygiene practices?	High	Yes	Low	Staff will be taught proper protocol on August 31st, 2020. Staff will teach all students proper handwashing/hygiene and frequently review steps/monitor. Everyone will sanitize upon reentering class. Posters will be placed at all handwashing stations.
What is the risk if people are unaware of proper respiratory etiquette?	High	Yes	Low	Everyone will be taught proper respiratory etiquette. Staff will be taught at orientation on August 31st. Staff will teach children and review frequently. There will be tissues available. Hands will be sanitized after.

What is the risk if people are unaware of when and how to wear community mask?	High	Yes	Low	Staff will be taught proper mask handling on August 31st. Staff will instruct students how to properly don and doff masks as per guidelines.
What is the risk if staff are unaware of where to find personal protective equipment?	High	Yes	Low	Each staff member will be receiving their own faceshield. Masks will be brought from home. Extra masks will be available in each class and at front lobby.
What is the risk if staff are not trained on the appropriate use and care of personal protective equipment and the sequence for putting it on and taking it off.	High	Yes	Low	Staff will be taught proper use and care on August 31st. Staff will teach students will be taught proper use and care and reminded frequently.
COMMUNICATION				
What is the risk if people do not receive reminders regarding health measures? (e.g., frequent hand hygiene, avoid touching the face, respiratory etiquette, clean and disinfect frequently touched surfaces with approved products)	Medium	Yes	Low	Posters will be placed as reminders, parents will receive any updates from Public Health. Staff will remind students frequently.
What is the risk if staff do not have access to Occupational Health & Safety Act & Regulation information. Ex: right to refuse.	Low	No	Low	Occupational Health and Safety Act posted in staffroom. Each staff member received email with information during the summer.
EMERGENCY PREPAREDNESS AND RESPONSE				
What is the risk if people are not prepared or aware of emergency procedures in the building (fire, lockdown, medical)	High	Yes	Low	Emergency drills will take place. Physical distancing rules may be broken but students will be encouraged to wear masks if possible. Muster areas will be moved to be further apart where possible.
What is the risk if people do not know how to react in an outbreak situation of Covid-19?	High	Yes	Low	Public Health will direct school on the proper procedures.

What is the risk if 1 metre physical distancing within classrooms is not being met?	N/A	N/A	N/A
