

## There are clubs for everyone!

*There are many opportunities to get involved here at KVHS and getting involved will add to your high school experience.*

*Not all of the clubs listed here will run this year, so listen to the announcements for club meetings or see the teacher listed in the description.*

### **Band – Concert**

We perform at events such as the Remembrance Day ceremony at the Q-Plex, the KVHS annual Christmas concert and the Atlantic Band Festival in Halifax. See Ms. Palmer in room 145.

**Band – Jazz** is for students in grades 9-12 who are interested in learning and performing music in a jazz style. See Ms. Palmer in room 145.

### Coffee Houses

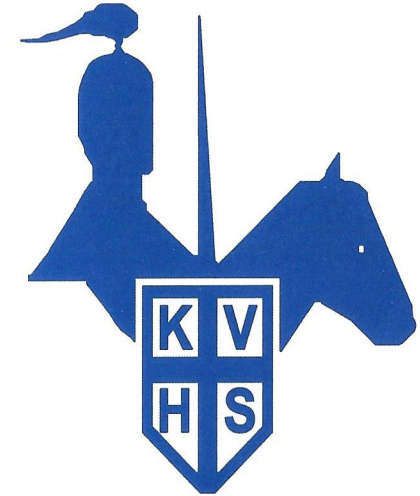
Come and enjoy the musical talents of your fellow students and if you're brave, get up on stage yourself! Snacks are provided. Admission is \$5.
