KVHS Athletic Information

- 1. <u>Sport Registration Form</u>: All athletes must fill out and return a sport registration form <u>before</u> trying out for any team. Hockey players must also fill out a hockey waiver form. Sport registration forms are available in the KVHS Main Office and on <u>www.edline.net</u>, click athletics. Hockey waiver forms are available on the NBIAA website.
- 2. <u>Behavior/Attitude</u>: All athletes must represent themselves appropriately in school with teachers, staff and students. Athletes must also be respectful to their coaches, teammates, opponents, officials and spectators.
- 3. <u>Attendance</u>: Athletes must be attendance in all of their classes on practice and game days. Athletes may participate in athletics if they miss class for a medical appointment or an excuse of a compassionate nature. Athletes who participate when they are ineligible due to attendance will be suspended from play for a minimum of 1 game in consultation with their coach.

Ex: missing class due to missing bus or illness is not an acceptable excuse for playing that day.

- 4. <u>Smoking</u>: KVHS recommends that athletes are not to be smoking during their sport season. First Offense: warning, Second Offense: minimum 1 game suspension, Third offense: removal from team.
- 5. <u>Alcohol and Drugs</u>: There is a zero tolerance policy for athletes involved with alcohol or drugs at any school event. Athletes who are involved in these activities will be removed from the team indefinitely.
- 6. <u>Driving</u>: Athletes cannot drive to out of town games which are defined as games that occur past West Saint John and east of Hampton. (Ex of games that student's cannot drive to would be Grand bay and Sussex). Students can drive other students to Saint John games if the students go home prior to going to the game and get parent permission. Students cannot drive other students directly from school to the game.
- 7. <u>Athletic Fees</u>: Each sport determines the athletic fee that is charged based on their financial need. The fee and the due date should be communicated by the coach to the athletes parents
- 8. <u>Dress code</u>: Each team can determine the dress code on game days, but KVHS asks that each athlete look presentable by refraining from wearing ripped clothing and all clothing that would not pass the District Dress Code.
- 9. <u>Insurance</u>: The NBIAA offers a secondary insurance policy for athletes who are injured playing a high school sport. All forms can be downloaded from the NBIAA website and must be returned within 2 weeks to the Athletic Director at the school. The school does not collect personal receipts for costs incurred from physiotherapy. Those can be sent directly to the insurance company once your claim has been filed. Hockey players: please make sure to download the hockey specific insurance form.
