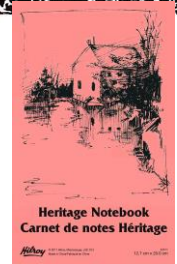
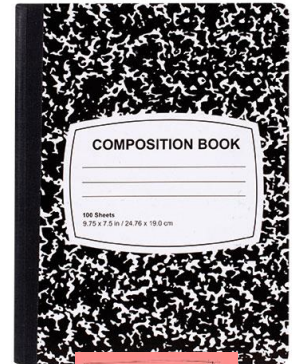
2020 – 2021 School Supply List – Grade Three English

- 4 – 80 page Hilroy scribblers (no coil)
- 50 pencils – recommend Staedtler brand
- 8 white erasers - recommend Staedtler brand
- 4 glue sticks
- 1 pair of scissors
- 5 Expo Dry Erase markers
- 2 yellow highlighters
- 1 – 50 pack of Crayola washable fine tip markers
- 1 - 24 pack of Crayola pencil crayons – sharpened please
- 1 – 24 pack of Crayola crayons
- 2 good pencil sharpeners with a cover - recommend Staedtler brand
- 30 cm ruler (clear plastic)
- 4 black Sharpie permanent markers
- 200 sheets of loose leaf
- 4 Campfire or Heritage notebooks (see image to right)
- 2 composition notebooks (see image to right, can be found at Dollarama)
- 1 basic set of watercolors (see image to right, recommend Prang sold at Great Canadian – no glitter please)
- 12 non-plastic duo-tangs - 2 of each color: purple, green, orange, blue, yellow, white
- 2 box of Ziploc bags – 1 large size & 1 small size
- 2 boxes of Kleenex (no lotion please)
- 1 inexpensive pair of headphones (in-ear or over-ear)
