Meeting began at 7:05 with Jason calling it to order.

The meeting began with introductions of all present and how they were connected to the school.

Anika, BRHS'S student council co president presented her report.

She shared all the events that the SRC put on to date.

- Terry Fox walk/run was held the first Friday afternoon of the school year. We did the walk and ended back at school with water gun games
